Corn

- Most common grain used for feed in the US
- Starch-based energy supplement
 - May decrease forage digestibility when fed with hay
- Very digestible and highly palatable
- Low in protein and high in energy, may require additional protein supplementation for growing cattle diets
- Cracking or rolling vs. fed whole will increase the digestibility



On average:
88% dry matter
90% TDN
9% crude protein
0.02% calcium
0.30% phosphorous
