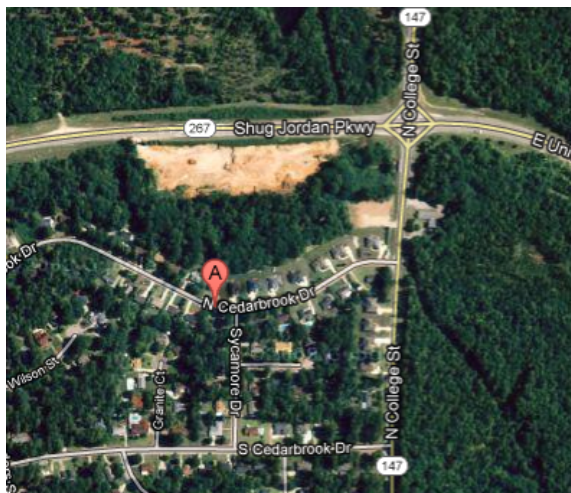


Are you experiencing minor streambank erosion?
