Dear Producer:

You are making application for a Private Applicator Permit to use or supervise the use of restricted use pesticides for the purpose of producing agricultural commodities on the property owned, rented or controlled by you. To secure this permit, you will be required to demonstrate competency to use or supervise the use of restricted use pesticides by passing a standard core examination which will indicate that you possess knowledge in the following areas:

1. Pest to be controlled and the damage they cause.
2. Read and understand the label and labeling information.
3. Application of pesticides in accordance with the label instructions and precautions.
4. Recognition of adverse effects of pesticides on man, animal and environment.
5. Recognition of poisoning symptoms and procedures to follow in the event of an accident.
6. Applicable state and federal laws and regulations.

The county agent's office (Alabama Cooperative Extension Service) is the locally designated agency to train private pesticide applicators and the place to secure the private pesticide applicator training manual and other material and an application for the permit. Your county agent will hold various training sessions throughout the year to provide the required information for testing. If you desire not to attend the training sessions, you may secure the training package from your county agent and study the material in your home at your leisure.

Upon completion of a training session or your study at home you will need to take the enclosed test and complete the enclosed application for the permit and submit these with the required fee of \$25.00 to the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries. An addressed envelope for your use has been enclosed.
